



## CARE OF THE SALTCRYSTAL LAMP

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR INNOVA PACIFIC CUSTOMERS

- Your Innova Pacific saltcrystal lamp has been carefully hand selected, inspected and packed by us. Each lamp is totally unique, in shape, colouring and size, and no two are exactly alike. Congratulations, you are now the owner of a "one-of-a-kind" saltcrystal lamp! Register your details via telephone, web or email for a 12-month warranty if you didn't purchase direct from Innova Pacific (contact details at bottom).

Some of a saltcrystal lamp's many uses are as a night light or bedside lamp, for mood lighting, beside computers and other electronic appliances to neutralise the electromagnetic radiation, during meditation, around smokers, and anywhere where you want to improve the quality of the air, enhance your well being or add a stunning touch to décor.

**These lamps are nurturing, beautiful and health giving! Just a few simple steps will keep them as good as new for many years.**

- Remember, these lamps are hygroscopic; this means they **absorb moisture from the environment**, so keep them away from water! **In very humid conditions or climates, it is strongly recommended that the lamp is lit continuously, and blown bulbs must be replaced immediately!** (The 15W or 25W bulbs use minimal electricity). This will ensure that they stay dry.

In fact, it is the lamps' ability to draw moisture from the air -- releasing moisture when warmed up by the bulb or candle -- which creates the special ionising and purifying effect. *If crystallisation or condensation occurs on its surface, it means you are not having the lamp switched on enough to evaporate the moisture.* Switch on continuously!

We recommend that you light your lamp every day for the best air purifying results.

- All Innova Pacific electric saltcrystal lamps are European in origin, the premium quality saltcrystal which will last a lifetime if cared for properly according to these instructions. European saltcrystal is much more resilient and denser than Himalayan saltcrystal, hence we have European saltcrystal for lamps, and Himalayan salt (which is more brittle and porous) for our bodycare products.

- Note for Tealight Lamps: Our pure beeswax tealight candles are easy to light, and also don't release paraffin fumes into the air. Normal paraffin candles release toxic paraffin fumes into the air, and are not recommended to be used in closed rooms.

- The **electric saltcrystal lamps** take a small 15W or 25W bulb of the "screw" as opposed to "twist" variety. A suggested brand is Crompton Pilot SES Clear (see below). They are readily available from a hardware outlet. The extra large saltcrystal lamps (11-17 kg) can take up to a 25-40W bulb.

- To change the bulb:

**Always keep a spare bulb handy!** If you delay in replacing the bulb, the saltcrystal may absorb too much moisture in the meantime.



#### **Current models of Saltcrystal Lamps.**

Turn the lamp over, and tug gently but firmly on the wire to extract the spring clip bulb (no unscrewing required). Older models require you to unscrew the fastening at the base of the lamp to loosen the wire first, then tug to extract the bulb attached to a spring clip.
